INSTRUCTION FOR ONLINE BID SUBMISSION

The bidders are required to submit soft copies of their bids electronically on the Central Public Procurement (CPP) Portal ie<http://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app> , using valid Digital Signature Certificates. The instructions given below are meant to assist the bidders in registering on the CPP Portal, prepare their bids in accordance with the requirements and submitting their bids online on the CPP Portal.

REGISTRATION

- (i) Bidders are required to enroll on the e-Procurement module of the Central Public Procurement Portal by using the "Online Bidder Enrollment" option available on the home page.**Enrolment on the CPP Portal is free of charge.**
- (i) During enrolment/ registration, the bidders should provide the correct/ true information including valid email-id & mobile no. All the correspondence shall be made directly with the contractors/ bidders through email-id provided.
- (ii) As part of the enrolment process, the bidders will be required to choose a unique username and assign a password for their accounts.
- (iii) For e-tendering possession of valid Digital Signature Certificate (Class II or Class III Certificates with signing key usage) is mandatory which can be obtained from SIFY /nCode/eMudra or any Certifying Authority recognized by CCA India on eToken/ Smartcard.
- (iv) Upon enrolment on CPP Portal for e-tendering, the bidders shall register their valid Digital Signature Certificate with their profile.
- (v) Only one valid DSC should be registered by a bidder. Bidders are responsible to ensure that they do not lend their DSCs to others which may lead to misuse and should ensure safety of the same.
- (vi) Bidders can than log into the site through the secured login by entering their user ID/ password and the password of the DSC/ eToken.

SEARCHING FOR TENDER DOCUMENTS

- (vii) There are various search options built in the CPP Portal to facilitate bidders to search active tenders by several parameters. These parameters could include Tender ID, organization name, location, date, value, etc. There is also an option of advanced search for tenders, wherein the bidders may combine a number of search parameters such as organization name, form of contract, location, date, other keywords, etc., to search for a tender published on the CPP Portal.
- (viii) Once the bidders have selected the tenders they are interested in, they may download the required documents / tender schedules. These tenders can be moved to the respective 'My Tenders' folder. This would enable the CPP Portal to intimate the bidders through SMS / e-mail in case there is any corrigendum issued to the tender document.
- (ix) The bidder should make a note of the unique Tender ID assigned to each tender, in case they want to obtain any clarification / help from the Helpdesk.

PREPARATION OF BIDS:

- (x) For preparation of bid Bidders shall search the tender from published tender list available on site and download the complete tender document and should take into account corrigendum if any published before submitting their bids.
- (xi) After selecting the tender document same shall be moved to the 'My favourite' folder of bidders account from where bidder can view all the details of the tender document.
- (xii) Bidder shall go through the tender document carefully to understand the documents required to be submitted as part of the bid. Bidders shall note the number of covers in which the bid documents have to be submitted, the number of documents – including the names and content of each of the document that need to be submitted. Any deviations from these may lead to rejection of the bid.
- (xiii) Any pre-bid clarifications if required, then same may be obtained online through the tender site, or through the contact details given in the tender document.
- (xiv) Bidders should get ready in advance the bid documents in the required format (PDF/xls/rar/dwf/jpg formats) to be submitted as indicated in the tender document/schedule. **Bid documents may be scanned with 100 dpi with black and white option which helps in reducing size of the scanned document.**
- (xv) Bidders can update well in advance, the documents such as experience certificates, annual report, PAN, EPF & other details etc., under "My Space/ Other Important Document" option, which can be submitted as per tender requirements. This will facilitate the bid submission process faster by reducing upload time of bids.

SUBMISSION OF BIDS:

- (xvi) Bidder should log into the site well in advance for bid submission so that he/ she upload the bid in time i.e. on or before the bid submission time. Bidder will be responsible for any delay due to other issues.
- (xvii) Bidder should prepare the Tender Fee and EMD as per the instructions specified in the NIT/ tender document. The details of the DD/BC/BG/ others physically sent, should tally with the details available in the scanned copy and the data entered during bid submission time. Otherwise the uploaded bid will be rejected.
- (xviii) While submitting the bids online, the bidder shall read the terms & conditions (of CPP portal) and accepts the same in order to proceed further to submit their bid.
- (xix) Bidders shall select the payment option as offline to pay the Tender Fee/ EMD and enter details of the DD/BC/BG/others.
- (xx) Bidder shall digitally sign and upload the required bid documents one by one as indicated in the tender document.
- (xxi) Bidders shall note that the very act of using DSC for downloading the tender document and uploading their offers is deemed to be a confirmation that they have read all sections and pages of the tender document without any exception and have understood the complete tender document and are clear about the requirements of the tender document.
- (xxii) Bid documents may be scanned with 100 dpi with black and white option which helps in reducing size of the scanned document. For the file size of less than 1 MB, the transaction uploading time will be very fast.
- (xxiii) **If price quotes are required in XLS format, utmost care shall be taken for uploading Schedule of quantities & Prices and any change/ modification of the price schedule shall render it unfit for bidding.**
Bidders shall download the Schedule of Quantities & Prices i.e. Schedule-A, in XLS format and save it without changing the name of the file. Bidder shall quote their rate in figures in the appropriate cells, thereafter save and upload the file in financial bid cover (Price bid) only.
If the template of Schedule of Quantities & Prices file is found to be modified/corrupted in the eventuality by the bidder, the bid will be rejected and further dealt as per provision of clause no 23.0 of ITB including forfeiture of EMD.
The bidders are cautioned that uploading of financial bid elsewhere i.e. other than in cover 2 will result in rejection of the tender.

- (xxiv) Bidders shall submit their bids through online e-tendering system to the Tender Inviting Authority (TIA) well before the bid submission end date & time (as per Server System Clock). **The TIA will not be held responsible for any sort of delay or the difficulties faced during the submission of bids online by the bidders at the eleventh hour.**
- (xxv) After the bid submission (i.e. after Clicking “Freeze Bid Submission” in the portal), the bidders shall **take print out of system generated acknowledgement number**, and keep it as a record of evidence for online submission of bid, which will also act as an entry pass to participate in the bid opening.
- (xxvi) Bidders should follow the server time being displayed on bidder’s dashboard at the top of the tender site, which shall be considered valid for all actions of requesting, bid submission, bid opening etc., in the e-tender system.
- (xxvii) All the documents being submitted by the bidders would be encrypted using PKI (Public Key Infrastructure) encryption techniques to ensure the secrecy of the data. The data entered cannot be viewed by unauthorized persons until the time of bid opening. The confidentiality of the bids is maintained using the secured Socket Layer 128-bit encryption technology.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Submission of Tenders– The detailed tender documents may be downloaded from <http://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app> till the last date of submission of tender. The Tender may be submitted online through CPP Portal

A-2.The bidder should submit the bid online in two parts viz. Technical Bid and Financial/Price Bid.

A-3. Technical Bid: Signed and Scanned copy of the Technical bid documents as under must be submit online on CPP Portal: <http://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app> .

a. List of Documents to be scanned and uploaded (Under Cover 1) within the period of bid submission: -

- i. Scanned copy of EMD (if Applicable) by way of Demand Draft or Banker's Cheque. SSI/MSE Units having valid registration with NSIC or DGS&D for category of items as against this tender will be exempted from payment of EMD. Such SSI/MSE Tenderers are required to enclose a certified copy of valid registration certificate to avail the exemption clearly showing the category of item for which the registration certificate has been issued by NSIC or DGS&D. If the Registration is for the category of Item other than what has been Tendered by the Corporation, the exemption from EMD will not be allowed/admissible and tenderer needs to submit full amount of EMD as per tender along with their TC-Bid only to avoid summarily rejection of their offer Demand Draft (tender EMD) as per Annexure – “A”
- ii. Scanned copy of GSTIN Registration Certificate, duly signed & stamped.
- iii. Scanned copy of tender Acceptance, duly sign & stamp (Annexure 'A').

A-4 Financial / Price Bid

- a. The currency of all quoted rates shall be Indian Rupees. All payment shall be made in Indian Rupees.
 - b. In preparing the financial bids, bidders are expected to take into account the requirements and conditions laid down in this Tender document. The financial bids should be uploaded online as per the specified “.xls” format i.e. **Annexure-B.xls** in Excel sheet attached as ‘.xls’ with the tender and based on the scope of work, service conditions and other terms of the Tender document. It should include all costs associated with the Terms of Reference/Scope of Work of the assignment.
 - c. The basic price/rate, Packing & Forwarding charges and Freight charges must be mentioned separately & Specifically. The offer quoted Inclusive of Packing & Forwarding Charges and freight charges may not be considered for further processing.
 - d. The Financial bid should be according to the. xlsformat given in the Tender Document. It should be ensured that no required value against an item is missed. If the bidder does not want to charge for an item, the value must be filled as “0” (ZERO).
 - (ii) Validity of Tenders – (a) The tenders shall remain open for acceptance for a minimum period of 90 days from the date of opening of tenders or till such period up to which the extension of validity is agreed to mutually. This may be please be stipulated clearly in the quotation. (b) If notified within this period that the tender has been accepted the tenderer shall be bound by the terms of the offer along with the terms that have been agreed to mutually. (c) All tenders without proper specification, samples, drawings and testing certificates. Where required, are liable to be rejected. It shall be in interest of tenderer that complete offer is made for our consideration.

 4. The GST Tax applicable shall clearly be indicated in %as well as Rupees. Our GSTIN No is 09AABCA8899F1Z6.
 5. D.G.S. and D Rate Contract – (a) Wherever the stores/equipment have been covered by the D.G.S and D rate contracts, the price shall conform to the same. A copy of current rate contract shall be enclosed for our ready reference. (b) Wherever the stores have not been covered under the D.G.S& D contract but under the rate contract of any State Stores Purchase Organization/Directorate of Industries, the price shall conform to the same. A copy of the current rate contract shall be enclosed for our ready reference.

6. Quantity Discounts – In order to submit the most competitive offer, the tenderer may indicate the quantity discount on a “slab basis” applicable on the price. However, the buyer reserves the right to accept the quantity discounts. The quantities indicated in this enquiry are liable to revision either upwards or downwards.
7. Delivery – (a) In their own interest, tenderers are advised to quote for the earliest possible delivery. Where ex-stock delivery’s quoted stock shall be held by the tenderer during the validity period quotation. (b) The delivery of the stores/equipment shall be made strictly as stipulated. Failure to supply within this period make the tenderers liable on to an unconditional penalty of ½% of the price of the goods in arrears per week subject to a maximum limit of 10% of value of the goods in arrears.
8. Terms & Payment – (a) Ours is a Government of India Undertaking registered under Section 25 of the Indian Companies Act 1956. As such the following terms of payment are stipulated: - (i) 100% within 30 days after receipt of the stores/equipment without any damage/short supplies.
9. Important instructions – (a) Where the item offered is not as per our specified make/size, the reason for not offering the same (e.g. not in ready stock etc.) shall be clearly indicated. (b) Please quote for free delivery at our factory site. However, Packing and Forwarding Charges wherever applicable shall be given clearly in % and Rupees.
10. Opening of Tenders – The tenders shall be opened at 15.30 hours on the specified bid Openingdate in presence of representatives of tenderers who may like to be present.
11. Tenderers should indicate their GST Registration No. in their quotations, failing which their offer will not be considered.
12. ALIMCO reserve the right to split up the total order quantity to more than 01 bidders to avoid stock out situation wherever necessary. In case of split up to 3 parties, 60% qty. may be placed on L-1 and 20% each on L-2 & L-3 provided they agree to match the rate with L-1 and in case of split up to 2 parties 60% qty. may be placed on L-1 and 40% on L-2 provided L-2 agree to match the rate with L-1.
13. If any dispute/question or controversy arises, the settlement of which is not herein specifically provided in this Tender/Order/Contract, the matter in dispute shall be referred to the arbitration of Chairman and Managing Director of ALIMCO Or his nominee and decision of Chairman and Managing Director or his nominee shall be final and binding on both the parties. The provision of INDIAN ARBITRATION & CONCILLATION ACT 1956 as amended from time to time shall apply to such arbitration proceedings. Arbitration proceeding shall be held at Kanpur only and Kanpur Nagar Court will have jurisdiction in the matter.
